Our primary target groups for this series are persons at the Ministry for Foreign Affairs and Sida, but also other stakeholders, who could benefit from this knowledge but do not actively search for and read new doctoral theses.

The reports are normally presented at a seminar at the Ministry for Foreign Affairs or Sida followed by a discussion on the policy relevance of the findings in the dissertation. This is an opportune moment to feed in knowledge to these groups about new research and about researcher's active in Sweden with competence of relevance for Swedish aid.
